Oral examination 1:

Oral examination 1 concerns basic knowledge of biomedical sciences or physical sciences/engineering/informatics. Questions are given in English, and you have to explain the answers in English. After your explanation, interviewers ask details of your answers in English or Japanese.

Oral examination 2:

Oral examination 2 concerns your research project proposal upon admission, and your career plan. You can use a projector (with connecting your own PC). The research project proposal must be an interdisciplinary research integrating biomedical sciences and physical sciences/engineering/informatics. The presentation and interview are conducted in English or Japanese.

Special Selection of Working Individuals

Candidates for this Ph.D. program must have at least two years of full-time or part-time research experience either biomedical sciences or physical sciences/engineering/informatics, and who are willing to study the other discipline and fuse them together. People who have worked as a physician or an engineer are also very welcome.
